

ROOFING LABOURER

A roofing labourer works alongside qualified roofers to help repair and replace slate, tile, and flat roofs.

DUTIES CAN INCLUDE:

Ensuring the site, you are based at, is kept clean and tidy

Introduction to the skills required to become a qualified roofer

Unloading and assisting with deliveries and moving materials

General Labouring duties

Working safely at heights

Working on historic or culturally significant buildings

Creating decorative lead or metal items in keeping with the structure

A roofing labourer can be on a project site from a few days to a few months, so this occupation should suit those who like to move workplaces on a regular basis. The work is varied and would suit individuals who prefer working outside.

EDUCATION NEEDED

GCSEs

Entry requirements for a roofing labourer - you will have achieved a GCSE Grade E to D (2 to 3) or above.

OTHER QUALIFICATIONS

It will also help you get a in roofing if you have already achieved some further education qualifications that are relevant to the job. This could include construction, engineering, or other 'hands-on' subjects.

WORK EXPERIENCE NEEDED

Roofing labourer jobs are designed for those with little to no direct work experience in the roofing sector.

Employers will always value any work experience that you have gained previously as it builds on your employability skills. This includes part-time work, volunteering and involvement in extracurricular activities.
