As a Trainee Surveyor you will be working alongside experienced surveyors and estimators to learn how to do the job.

As a trainee surveyor, you will carry out your duties across the flat roofing, pitched roofing and construction division.

DUTIES CAN INCLUDE:

- Scaffolding

Attending site undertaking full measured surveys

Meeting with specialist subcontractors

Post site survey works including:

- Producing accurate bills of quantity
- Site plans / drawings
- Sending sub-contractor enquiries.

Trainee Surveyors will have a mix of both onsite and office-based working, so this occupation should suit those who like to move workplaces on a regular basis. The work is varied and would suit individuals who prefer working outside.

EDUCATION NEEDED

GCSEs

Entry requirements for a Trainee Surveyor - you will have achieved a GCSE Grade C or above (4+) in Maths or English / key skills equivalent.

OTHER QUALIFICATIONS

It will also help you get a trainee job in roofing if you have already achieved some further education qualifications that are relevant to the job. This could include construction, engineering, or other 'hands-on' subjects. A full UK driving licence is required, a company vehicle will be provided to fulfil the role.

WORK EXPERIENCE NEEDED

Trainee jobs are designed for those with little to no direct work experience in the roofing sector.
